

Study Introduction



The Colorado Division of Aeronautics has undertaken a study of the economic impact of all public-use airports in the state. The goal of this study is to quantify and publicize the positive economic benefits these airports provide to the state and their local communities. The results of this effort are presented in this Executive Summary.

Colorado public-use airports generate a total of \$23.5 billion in economic activity, and are responsible for over 280,000 jobs, and nearly \$10 billion in wages. They also provide innumerable qualitative resources and services for local communities.
